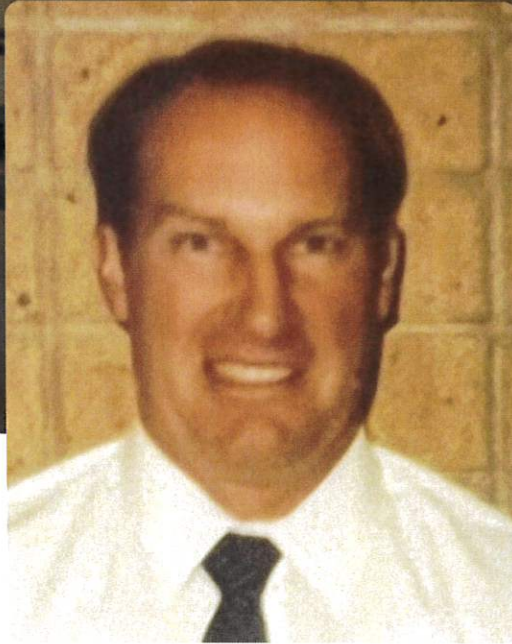

Scott Lund Hintze, age 74, passed away June 12, 2024 at Mountain View hospital in Payson, Utah surrounded by family.
