

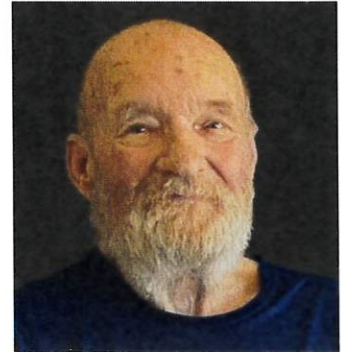
## Richard J Robbins - Walker Funeral Home
