

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A SEWER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT MASTER PLAN, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Santaquin City (the "City") is a political subdivision of the State of Utah, authorized and organized under applicable provisions of Utah law; and

**WHEREAS**, Santaquin has experienced tremendous growth in the past and anticipates more growth in the future; and

**WHEREAS**, a sewer collection and treatment master plan (Sewer Plan) is necessary for the management of wastewater within the community, and Santaquin anticipates needing to expand its collection and treatment systems and facilities as future growth occurs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City commissioned JUB Engineers Inc to prepare a Sewer Plan to establish long term plans for management of wastewater collection and treatment infrastructure in the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF Santaquin CITY, STATE OF UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I. Adoption of Sewer Collection and Treatment Master Plan**

The attached Sewer Plan is hereby adopted as the official Santaquin City Sewer Collection and Treatment Master Plan.

**SECTION II. Codification, Inclusion in the Code, and Scrivener's Errors**

It is the intent of the City Council that the provisions of this ordinance be made part of the City Code as adopted, that sections of this ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered, that the word ordinance may be changed to section, chapter, or other such appropriate phrase in order to accomplish such intent regardless of whether such inclusion in a code is accomplished, sections of the ordinance may be re-numbered or re-lettered. Typographical errors which do not affect the intent of this ordinance may be authorized by the City without need of public hearing by its filling a corrected or re-codified copy of the same with the City Recorder.

**SECTION III. Severability**

If any section, phrase, sentence, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**SECTION IV. Effective Date**

The City Recorder shall deposit a copy of this ordinance in the official records of the City on January 5, 2017, and before 5:00 p.m. on that day, shall place a copy of this ordinance in three places within the City. This ordinance shall become effective at 5:00 p.m. on January 5, 2017.


